Having passed this examination, the candidate is eligible for the floor examination. NOTE: On this examination, "In the act of shooting" means the ball is still in the hands of the shooter. "Tap," is defined as "the same as a try."

1.	While A-1's pass is in flight, A-2 commits a common foul against B-1. Team B is in the bonus. The official awards B-1 a one-and-one. Is the official correct?	1.	Yes No
2.	Prior to releasing the ball on a pass, A-1 lifts his/her pivot foot off the floor. The official rules a violation. Is the official correct?	2.	Yes No
3.	On the jump ball to start the game, non-jumper A-2 secures the ball. The official has the scorer set the arrow toward Team B's basket. Is the official correct?	3.	Yes No
4.	A-1, while airborne, catches the ball. As A-1's momentum is carrying him/her out of bounds, A-1 requests a time-out. The official grants the request. Is the official correct?	4.	Yes No

25. Yes No 25. Airborne shooter A-1 is fouled prior to returning to the floor. The official rules A-1 was fouled while in the act of shooting. Is the official correct?
26. Yes No 26. A-1, while airborne, catches the ball and lands on both feet simultaneously. A-1 pivots prior to passing the ball. The official rules a legal play. Is the official correct?
27. Yes No 27. During a throw-in with three-tenths of a second on the game clock, A-2 catches the ball and attempts a try for goal. The try is successful. The official counts the goal. Is the official correct?
28. Yes No 28. During a designated spot throw-in, A-1 moves directly backwards four feet to avoid the defensive pressure. The official rules a violation for leaving the designated spot. Is the official correct?
29. Yes No 29. The official beckons substitute A-6 into the game to replace A-5. When A-6 legally enters the court, A-5 becomes bench personnel. Is this correct?
30. Yes No 30. The head coach of Team A is charged with an indirect technical foul. The official informs the scorer that that foul counts as a team foul to reach the bonus. Is the official correct?
31. Yes No 31. Jumper A-1 taps the ball which is simultaneously deflected out of bounds by A-2 and B-2. The official rules play shall resume with a jump ball between the original jumpers. Is the official correct?

37. Yes No 37. A-1, while dribbling from the backcourt to frontcourt, has both feet in the frontcourt while the ball is being dribbled in the backcourt. The official continues the 10-second count. Is the official correct?

39. Yes No 39. After an initial legal guarding position is obtained, a guard may jump within his/her vertical plane and still have a legal guarding position. Is this correct?

42. Yes No 42. A-1 jumps into the air to try for goal. A-1, seeing the try may be blocked, drops the ball to the floor. A-1 returns to the floor and catches the ball. The official rules a traveling violation. Is the official correct?
43. Yes No 43. Team A is assessed a technical foul prior to the game. The official allows B-6 to substitute for designated starter B-5 to attempt the free throws. Is the official correct?
44. Yes No 44. A-1's throw-in pass is caught by A-2 who is in the air from the frontcourt. A-2 lands in the backcourt. The official rules a backcourt violation. Is the official correct?
45. Yes No 45. Prior to A-1's free throw being released, B-2 enters the lane followed by A-2, both of whom are in marked lane spaces. The try is unsuccessful. The official penalizes B-2's violation and ignores A-2's violation. Is the official correct?
46. Yes No 46. While A-1 is dribbling in the backcourt, B-1 bats the ball away from A-1. The official continues the 10-second count. Is the official correct?
