This examination will be given on Monday, November 7, 2022. Carefully read each situation described. Draw a circle around the correct answer, “Yes-No”. The rulebook may not be used during the examination. In order to pass, the examinee must correctly answer a minimum of 43 questions. Having passed this examination, the candidate is eligible for the floor examination. NOTE: On this examination, “In the act of shooting” means the ball is still in the hands of the shooter. “Tap,” is defined as “the same as a try.”

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| 1. A-1 controls a rebound and falls to the floor while holding the ball. The official rules a traveling violation. Is this correct? | 1. | Yes | No |
| 2. While the ball is at the disposal of a player for a throw-in, the ball is live. Is this correct? | 2. | Yes | No |
| 3. Airborne shooter A-1 charges into B-1 who has a legal guarding position. The try is successful. The official charges A-1 with a player control foul and counts the goal. Is this correct? | 3. | Yes | No |
| 4. A-1 starts a drive to the basket along the end line. B-1 places two hands on A-1 momentarily. The official rules a handchecking foul. Is this correct? | 4. | Yes | No |
| 5. After A-1 jumps to attempt a try, B-1 moves into A-1’s landing area. A-1 collides with B-1. The official rules a player control foul. Is this correct? | 5. | Yes | No |
| 6. A–1, closely guarded in the frontcourt, dribbles the ball for four seconds and then catches the ball. The official starts a new count. Is this correct? | 6. | Yes | No |
| 7. The act of shooting starts with the habitual motion that precedes the release of a try. Is this correct? | 7. | Yes | No |
| 8. During a jump ball, jumper A–1 catches the ball prior to the jump ball ending. The official rules a violation. Is this correct? | 8. | Yes | No |

| 10. A-1 and B-1 push each other at approximately the same time during a dead ball. The official rules a double technical foul, awards no free throws, and resumes play at the point of interruption. Is this correct? | 10. | Yes | No |
| 11. A-1 dives for a loose ball. After securing control of the ball on the floor, momentum causes A-1 to slide several feet. The official rules a legal play. Is this correct? | 11. | Yes | No |
| 12. While the ball is in flight on a pass between A–1 and A–2, the Team A head coach requests a time-out. The official grants the request. Is this correct? | 12. | Yes | No |
| 13. A-1 sets a screen on stationary B-2 outside B-2’s visual field. B-2 begins to step but, prior to placing a foot on the floor, contacts A-1. The official rules a legal play. Is this correct? | 13. | Yes | No |
| 14. A-1 has control of the ball above the semi-circle when A-2 and B-2 commit a double personal foul in the lane. The official resumes play by awarding the ball to Team A nearest where the double foul was committed. Is this correct? | 14. | Yes | No |
| 15. A-1’s try is on its downward flight, outside the imaginary cylinder, above the level of the ring with a chance of entering the basket when B-1 bats the ball away. The official rules goaltending. Is this correct? | 15. | Yes | No |
| 16. Team A scores. B-1’s throw-in is intentionally kicked by A-2 near the end line. Official awards the ball to Team B and rules B-1 retains the privilege of moving along the end line. Is this correct? | 16. | Yes | No |

| 19. A-1, in the backcourt, throws the ball toward the frontcourt. B-1, in the frontcourt, bats the ball back to A-1 in the backcourt. The official starts a new 10-second count. Is this correct? | 19. | Yes | No |

| 21. A–1 is in the act of shooting when B–2 fouls A–2. A–1 continues the motion. The ball enters the basket. The official disallows the goal. Is this correct? | 21. | Yes | No |
| 22. B-1 commits a flagrant personal foul against A-1. The official awards A-1 two free throws, awards Team A a throw-in at the spot out of bounds nearest to the foul, and disqualifies B-1. Is this correct? | 22. | Yes | No |
| 23. A-1 is fouled and awarded two free throws. After the foul is reported, the timer sounds the horn for A-6 to substitute. The official beckons A-6 into the game. Is this correct? | 23. | Yes | No |
| 24. Prior to any warning for delay, during a throw-in by A-1, B-1 breaks the plane of the boundary line. The official issues a warning to Team B. Is this correct? | 24. | Yes | No |
| 25. A-1 is driving to the basket for a layup. B-2 obtains a legal guarding position and jumps vertically with his/her hands extended within the vertical plane. A-1’s momentum causes contact with B-2. The official rules B-2’s position is legal. Is this correct? | 25. | Yes | No |

26. Yes No 26. A-1's throw-in is touched by A-2 in the frontcourt and goes directly into the backcourt. A-1 retrieves the ball in the backcourt. The official rules a backcourt violation. Is this correct?
27. Yes No 27. The officials' jurisdiction ends and the final score is approved when all officials leave the visual confines of the court. Is this correct?
28. Yes No 28. B-1 obtains a legal guarding position on dribbler A-1 when B-1 gets in A-1's path with both feet touching the playing court and facing A-1. Is this correct?
29. Yes No 29. After 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time, the coach of Team A adds two names to the team member list in the scorebook. The official assesses Team A one technical foul. Is the official correct?
30. Yes No 30. An interrupted dribble occurs when the ball momentarily gets away from the dribbler. Is this correct?
31. Yes No 31. The official charges B-2 with a technical foul for excessively swinging arms and elbows without contacting an opponent. Is this correct?

34. Yes No 34. A-1 attempts a try. While the ball is in the imaginary cylinder above the ring, A-5 jumps and touches the ring. The official rules basket interference. Is this correct?
35. Yes No 35. A-1 establishes the right foot as the pivot foot. A-1 steps with the left foot and picks up the pivot foot before releasing the ball on a pass. The official rules a traveling violation on A-1. Is this correct?
36. Yes No 36. Post player A-5 has only one foot in the free throw lane while A-1 is dribbling the ball in the frontcourt. After three seconds, the official rules a violation. Is this correct?
37. Yes No 37. After obtaining an initial legal guarding position, B-1 may move laterally or obliquely to maintain that position on a dribbler. Is this correct?
38. Yes No 38. Dribbler A-1 is contacted by B-1 after time expires. The official ignores the contact because the contact was neither intentional nor flagrant. Is this correct?
